ERRG was awarded a task order under the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Superfund Technical Assessment and Emergency Response Team (START) contract to provide prevention and preparedness support for various quarterly tasks in California and Arizona.

ERRG is working with USEPA and NORTHCOM to provide strategic programmatic, technical, administrative, and scientific functions throughout the Southwest to successfully execute the US/Mexico Border Building Partnership Capacity Knowledge Exchange.



The objective of Border 2012 is to develop US/Mexico border response capacity and to work in a unified manner for any potential hazards that may impact the border area, as well as to develop a bilateral approach to reducing the impact of environmental concerns to the human health of over 12 million people in the border region.

“Sister Cities” have been identified along the entire US/Mexican border. ERRG is supporting southwest sister city activities, specifically for Tijuana/San Diego; Calexico/Mexicali; San Luis Rio Colorado/Yuma; Nogales/Nogales; Naco/Naco; and Douglas/Agua Prieta. ERRG is supporting the USEPA sponsored activities with 1) Four Sister City Binational Emergency Operations Plan Updates, 2) Hazardous Materials Technician Training Sister City Binational Exercises, and 3) Border 2012 Meeting/Capacity Building Support.

Four Sister City Binational Emergency Operations Plan Updates - ERRG is reviewing current Emergency Operation Plans (EOPs), identifying data gaps, and revising plans. Once completed, the EOPs will be exercised. ERRG is also providing a range of technical trainings for emergency responders.

Hazardous Materials Technician Training Sister City Binational Exercises - ERRG continues to develop, implement, and evaluate a model template exercise schedule for the Border 2012 Program.
