

# Projects

ERRG was contracted by Cochise County, Arizona to combine response plans from Cochise County, Naco Arizona, Naco Sonora, Douglas Arizona and Agua Prieta Sonora. The resulting plan is a Binational All Hazards Response Plan that border Sister Cities will use in emergency response. The specific plan scope included plans and data collection, stakeholder meetings, text consolidation, All Hazards revision, appendix generation, draft production, addressing draft version comments, and generation of the final document.



Word versions of the existing plans were gathered, plan revision data was collected and the existing plans were assessed for best combination and inclusion. The text of the existing plans was combined into one document and updated with current response resources from both sides of the border.

Current response methodologies were integrated in the updated All Hazards Plan. One of ERRG's goals was to develop a standardized format to be used to revise other applicable Sister City Plans, such as Imperial County, California; Mexicali Baja California; San Diego, California; and Tijuana, Baja California.

The appendices of the plans were evaluated for usefulness in the combined plan, in some cases additional data was gathered to develop completely new appendices. The new text and appendices were compiled and a draft version of the document was forwarded to the client for review. The comments received were incorporated into the document and a final version of the document was generated.

During the plan development process, stakeholder meetings were conducted to ensure the correct data was collected and to ensure the project was proceeding the way the client had intended. Of particular significance was the All Hazards approach to emergency response that was introduced into the combined plan.
