ERRG supported site investigation and remediation efforts at the Hamilton Army Airfield (HAAF) as a subcontractor under a Total Environmental Restoration Contract (TERC) with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Sacramento District. HAAF is composed of three individual parcels including the 760-acre Base Realignment and Closure Act (BRAC) parcel; the 260-acre General Service Administration (GSA) Phase II Sale Area parcel; and the 270-acre North Antenna Field (NAF) parcel. For the BRAC parcel, ERRG



assisted with preparation of a risk assessment, a focused feasibility study, and management of hazardous and non-hazardous waste streams.

ERRG's involvement with the GSA Phase II Sale Area property included assistance in preparing the interim removal action workplan, coordination and oversight for removal of 29,000 cubic

yards of contaminated soil and sediment, a risk assessment, and preparation of a removal action completion report. Additionally, within the GSA Phase II Sale Area, ERRG performed a comprehensive evaluation of previous closure documents for Landfill 26 for the purpose of reviewing site conditions in regards to specific items, such as gas monitoring and groundwater monitoring programs, leachate monitoring and control, stormwater control and monitoring, surface water drainage, erosion, seasonal ponding, landfill settlement issues, site security, and structure removal.

For the NAF project, ERRG assisted in preparation of the remedial investigation work plans for a comprehensive sitewide remedial investigation; conducting the investigation in the field, and completing the remedial investigation report.
