

# Projects

ERRG was contracted by Navy Region Hawaii to conduct intermediate ICS 300 Training with a follow-on Field Exercise for Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility within Pearl Harbor's secured Controlled Industrial Area (CIA). The ICS 300 Training was held over a three day period and conducted at Hawaii's premier Spill Response Center one week prior to the exercise. Students were taken on an in-depth tour of the Response Center and learned how to layout an ICP during an emergency.



The Intermediate Maintenance Facility is a non-mixed waste reception facility within the CIA that supports the nuclear submarine program. The facility itself does not store any radioactive material but is within a heavily secured area. This was the first time the emergency response plan and facility personnel conducted an exercise to evaluate their response capability and fully integrate outside emergency service

personnel inside the CIA fence line. The event generated significant interest throughout the Navy's CIA, as it was also the first time that the ICS was introduced as a response option.

ERRG worked closely with Navy Region to understand the role of the Intermediate Maintenance Facility and lead them through a complex scenario designed to test pre-identified objectives. The exercises involved a complete response of Federal Fire, Police, and EMS, all coordinated through their Regional Dispatch Center.

ERRG delivered a comprehensive After Action Report and Improvement Plan to Navy Region. ERRG was also requested to attend the Admiral's Brief to discuss future drills, exercises, and training opportunities to maintain momentum.
